A brief history

In 1938, Vaughn Groom established Garden of the Gulf cabins, adding a motel in 1952, known as Quality Inn and Suites. Years later, in 1971, brothers Alfred and Don Groom purchased the motel from their father and, on July 13 of the same year, opened Brothers 2 Restaurant.

Don became the sole owner of Brothers 2 in 1976. And Alfred took over the Garden of the Gulf and Quality Inn. Don then established Feast Dinner Theatres in 1979.

In 2009, David Groom became the owner of Brothers 2 and is now the owner and operator of all the properties, including Brothers 2, Quality Inn, and Feast Dinner Theatres.

Flashforward to 2021

David says, “50 years of success has come from creating a great experience including good food, wonderful staff and a fun and friendly environment focused on serving super guests.”

Brothers 2 has served many notable people, including four prime ministers. Pierre Trudeau, his son, the current minister of Canada, Justin Trudeau and former prime ministers Joe Clark and Brian Mulroney. Several celebrities, such as Eric Clapton, model Patti Boyd, also dined at the Summerside restaurant.
